

Rules

"Asylum presents Berghel Mental Hospital" is a first-person horror experience that includes actors who create particularly intense situations of fear and fright.

The situations, sudden and unexpected, take place in dark environments, through stairs and confined spaces. Sound effects, strobe lights, smoke, and scenic elements can cause disorientation in more sensitive individuals, including those prone to photosensitive epilepsy.

The actors are authorized to touch the guests and perform staged "tortures" on them, during which they may get dirty or wet. For this reason, it is recommended to wear clothing appropriate for the situation.

Entry is prohibited to those under 18. Guests participating in this experience will be required to sign a waiver in which they confirm they are in good health and authorize the actors to perform their staged actions while always respecting the participants' safety. Guests are strictly prohibited from reacting against the actors or damaging the scenery and stage props.

Entry is prohibited to:

- MINORS UNDER 18 YEARS OLD
- PEOPLE WITH HEART PROBLEMS, BREATHING ISSUES, ASTHMA, THOSE IN PHYSICALLY DEBILITATING CONDITIONS AND PREGNANT WOMEN THOSE WHO SUFFER FROM CLAUSTROPHOBIA, EPILEPSY, OR PANIC ATTACKS
- PEOPLE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL
- PEOPLE WHO ARE EASILY DISTURBED
- PEOPLE WITH FOOD AND/OR DRINKS

Inside the experience:

- IT IS FORBIDDEN TO RUN
- IT IS FORBIDDEN TO USE FORCE IN ANY SITUATION
- IT IS FORBIDDEN TO TOUCH ACTORS AND SETS
- BAGS AND BACKPACKS MUST BE CARRIED WITH YOU
- THE USE OF ELECTRONIC DEVICES TO CAPTURE IMAGES AND VIDEOS IS PROHIBITED
- NO LIGHT SOURCES SUCH AS FLASHLIGHTS, FLASHES OR CELL PHONES ARE

ALLOWED

IF YOU ARE TOO SCARED OR FEELING UNWELL, SHOUT **"FATHER JOSEF HELP ME"** AND THE STAFF WILL GUIDE YOU OUT SAFELY

IN CASE OF RULE VIOLATIONS OR BEHAVIOUR THAT COULD COMPROMISE THE SAFETY AND WELL-BEING OF PARTICIPANTS AND/OR ACTORS, THE STAFF MAY IMMEDIATELY STOP THE EXPERIENCE AND EXCLUDE THE DISRUPTIVE GUESTS.
